ONLINE CRIME REPORTING

Is available if:

- You have no witness nor suspect
- ♣ You have lost something that costs less than \$5,000
- Someone has stolen something from you that costs less than \$5,000
- Someone has vandalized your property or car and it will cost less than \$5,000 to repair
- There are no items involving personal identity, firearms, license plates or decals
- You provide a valid e-mail address and provide your personal information; anonymous reports are not permitted
