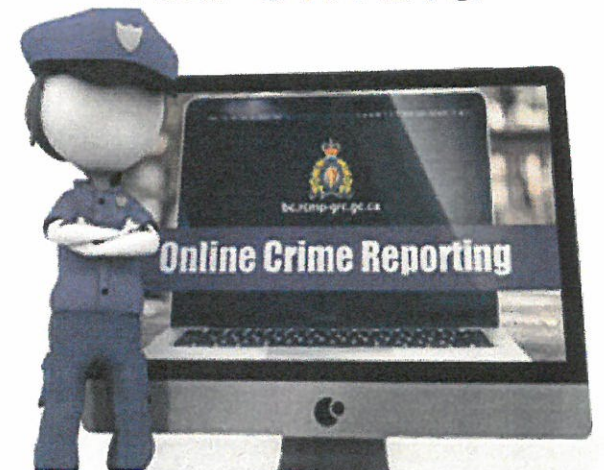

# To report a crime that has already been committed

## Report the following Crimes On-Line

- Damage/Mischief to Property under \$5,000
- Damage/Mischief to Vehicle under \$5,000
- Hit & Run to Unoccupied Vehicle or Property
- Lost Property
- Theft of Bicycle under \$5,000
- Theft under \$5,000
- Theft from Vehicle under \$5,000

## ONLINE CRIME REPORTING

Is available if:

- ✚ You have no witness nor suspect
- ✚ You have lost something that costs less than \$5,000
- ✚ Someone has stolen something from you that costs less than \$5,000
- ✚ Someone has vandalized your property or car and it will cost less than \$5,000 to repair
- ✚ There are no items involving personal identity, firearms, license plates or decals
- ✚ You provide a valid e-mail address and provide your personal information;  
*anonymous reports are not permitted*
