1. Plan your route and avoid isolated areas.

- 2. Be aware of your surroundings.
- 3.Be alert, don't be distracted.
- 4. Carry your purse or bag between your arms and body.
- 5. Don't display cash in public.
- If you believe you are being followed, go to the nearest business or group of people for help.
- 7. If walking at night make sure you wear reflective clothing so you are seen.
- 8. Avoid empty and dark alleys/streets.

- 1. Make sure to accompany yourself with a friend.
- 2. Avoid travelling into isolated areas.
- 3. Stay alert and don't use headphones.
- 4. Alternate your route and don't be predictable.
- 5. Always wear reflective gear at night.
- 6. Carry a cell phone for emergencies.
- 7. Follow the rules and regulations of the road.

- 1. Always plan your route ahead of time.
- 2. Avoid isolated and poor lit transit stops.
- 3. Be aware of your surroundings when waiting at transit stops.
- 4. Ensure you are not being followed while leaving the transit stop.
- 5. Plan your seat; sit near the front or middle of the bus.
