(a) Updated 2023 Meeting Schedule

(b) Affordable Housing Strategy Implementation

i. Housing Coordinator Updates

Affordable Housing Innovation Day

- M. Dickinson provided the Committee with an update on the discussion topics planned for the upcoming Affordable Housing Innovation Day, which encompass:
 - policy partnerships, and Innovation Intergovernmental Perspectives;
 - faith in Mission;
 - safe and secure rental housing and practices in Mission; and
 - private sector perspectives related to affordable housing creation.

The event is being held on June 14, 2023 at Northview Church in Mission. Committee members are encouraged to attend.

Density Bonusing Program and CAC Review

The consultants are examining the density bonusing program and community amenity policy to form data for an economic analysis. Their analysis will serve as a foundation for creating policies and bylaws for the Affordable Housing Reserve Fund. The consultants will also be looking at other BC municipalities for best practices to inform the density bonusing review.

Safe and Secure Housing Strategies

D. Kae Beno will be looking at safe and secure housing strategies (housing demolitions, approaches for relocating tenants when there's new development).

Discussion ensued and the Committee requested that staff provide an update on the number of new in-stream residential units, including if any are for families (e.g., 2-3+ bedroom units). Furthermore, it was agreed that this be a standing item on the upcoming agendas of this Committee. It was noted that staff will be providing an Affordable Housing Strategy quarterly report to Council in August. This report will also include a data update that informs the status of unit amounts and types.

(c) Housing for Refugees and Newcomers

Kim Reddicopp of Fraser Valley Refugee Readiness Team (FV RRT) provided an overview to the Committee on who this team is, and how they are working to provide aid to the cities of Mission, Abbotsford, Chilliwack, Maple Ridge, and Pitt Meadows. The Team is funded by the Provincial Government to ensure these communities are prepared to accommodate and respond effectively to the requirements of Afghan refugees and displaced Ukrainians. The FV RRT focuses on four main areas: housing, healthcare, information coordination, and employment.

A community information session is being held at Copper Hall in Mission on Monday, June 26, 2023, from 7:00 pm to 9:00 pm. The session will offer insights on renting to newcomers, with refugees and displaced Ukrainians sharing experiences and housing challenges. Professionals from various fields will join the panel for a discussion. Committee members are encouraged to attend.
